Answering questions from prospective bidders regarding Distribution Transformers.

Q: Would you happen to have 2025 purchase history on all the transformer sizes you could share or an estimated need for the upcoming year on particular ones? Manufacturers are asking so they can consider that for cost and timing.

A: We do not have that data available. We plan to purchase as needed with a lead time. This bid is being solicited for pricing to purchase transformers for FY 2026-2027 and we cannot anticipate quantity or size.

Q: Is there a posting of plan holders for the Electric Distribution Transformers bid? We are an electrical contractor looking to bid this work.

A: There is no posting of plan holders for the Electric Distribution Transformers bid. This bid is for Material Only.

Q: I've received your bid request for Distribution Transformers, 26-1, and am inquiring if The City of Geneva would accept transformers made in Asia and then shipped to the U.S to complete manufacturing? Just to clarify, it would be just the core/coil of the transformer(s) manufactured in Asia with the rest of the transformer to complete manufacturing in the US.

A: No, those transformers would not be accepted. The bidder may propose equipment produced by foreign-owned companies, provided that all such equipment is domestically manufactured in the United States.
