



2019 City of Geneva Speed Control Policy Task Force

Purpose:

Review existing City of Geneva Speed Control Policy and, if necessary, make recommendations to the Committee of the Whole / City Council for amending said policy moving forward.

Composition:

11 members total. 2 from each Ward and 1 "at large" member. The Task Force will elect a Chairperson and said Chairperson will serve as the ex-officio member of the Task Force and vote on recommendations only when a tie vote amongst the other members occur.

City of Geneva Staff Liaisons From:

- Administration / Police Department / Public Works Department

Procedural Rules:

The Task Force will operate under the rules governing public meetings of the City of Geneva including:

- All meetings will be open to the public and held in locations that are ADA accessible (City Hall, Fire Department Headquarters, and Public Works)
- All meetings will be posted with 48 hours advanced notice
- All meetings will be audio recorded
- Task Force members will adhere to the Illinois Open Meetings Act and be required to successfully complete online Open Meeting Act training
- Task Force members will be provided City of Geneva email addresses for internal and external communication purposes
