RE: Commuter Parking Permits – Fourth Quarter 2021

In June 2021, the State of Illinois successfully entered Phase 5 of Governor Pritzker's Restore Illinois Plan. As we continue to move towards a return to normal operations, the City of Geneva will resume quarterly permit payments and daily parking fees.

Effective September 30, 2021, any currently held City of Geneva commuter parking permit placard will expire. No extensions or grace period will be provided beyond that date. Permit holders must renew their permit for the fourth quarter of 2021, which begins October 1, 2021 and runs through December 31, 2021. Any permit not renewed prior to the new quarter will be reassigned and applicant will be returned to the waiting list.

As indicated in previous correspondence, the City will be moving to an online renewal program to better facilitate the permit process. Included with this letter is the fourth quarter invoice for your permit. Using the information on the invoice, an online account can be created to pay the required amount. Detailed instructions on how to make the payment are available on the City's website. After the invoice payment is received, the City will mail the new valid permit. Any old expired permits should be destroyed by the permit holder. All permit holders are required to follow all guidelines and regulations as described on the permit application. Failure to do so will result in the loss of the parking permit. Additional parking information and current updates are available on the City's website at [www.geneva.il.us](http://www.geneva.il.us).
